Sir/Madam

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021.

1. It is pertinent to mention here that conditional permission to take admission with **100 seats (125 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 46 seats in 12 PG course (58 seats including EWS) namely (i) Kayachikitsa-04 seats (05 seats including EWS) (ii) Rasa Shastra and Bhaisajya Kalpana - 02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (iii) Ayurveda Samhita and Siddhant - 02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (iv) Rachna Sharir - 03 seats (04 seats including EWS) (v) Kriya Sharir - 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (vi) Swasthavritta -02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (vii) Prasuti Tantra & Stri Roga - 02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (viii) Shalakyata Tantra - 05 seats (06 seats including EWS) (ix) Shalaya Tantra - 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (x) Kaumarbhritya-06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (xi) Dravyaguna Vigyan-02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (xii) Roga Nidan avum Vikriti Vigyan- 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2022-23 was issued to you on the basis of undertaking submitted vide letter no. DAMS/NCISM/GAC/Deficiencies-Undertaking/2022/AY-2/12714 dated 10.11.2022 by the Director of AYUSH, Government of Maharashtra and vide letter no. AYUSH/1122/C.R.115/Ayu-I dated 09.11.2022 by the Secretary, Medical Education and Drug Department, Mantralaya, Mumbai in respect of fulfillment of all the shortcomings within stipulated time period in respect of deficiencies pointed out in respect of 1st appeal filed in the commission for issuance of conditional permission for academic year 2022-23.**
2. Further, to assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, Hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college namely **Government Ayurved College, Vazirabad, Nanded, Maharashtra-431601 (Inst. Id- AYU0185)** inspection of your College was conducted on **15.05.2023 & 16.05.2023 on Hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and rating Board, NCISM to process **the Conditional Permission with 100 seats (125 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 46 seats in 12 PG course (58 seats including EWS) in the subject namely (i) Kayachikitsa-04 seats (05 seats including EWS) (ii) Rasa Shastra and Bhaisajya Kalpana - 02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (iii) Ayurveda Samhita and Siddhant - 02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (iv) Rachna Sharir - 03 seats (04 seats including EWS) (v) Kriya Sharir - 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (vi) Swasthavritta -02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (vii) Prasuti Tantra & Stri Roga - 02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (viii) Shalakyata Tantra - 05 seats (06 seats including EWS) (ix) Shalaya Tantra - 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (x) Kaumarbhritya-06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (xi) Dravyaguna Vigyan-02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (xii) Roga Nidan avum Vikriti Vigyan- 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24.**
3. Further, in view of above, the visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulation namely, the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda

Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", The Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations there under. On examining the case in light of above notified and approved criteria and on perusal of the visitation report, it was observed that the college was not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria due to following shortcomings: -

1. **Teaching Staff: -**

4. In view of above, the assessment report was placed in the **42nd Board meeting** of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) on **07.06.2023**. On careful examination of the assessment report, considering the deficiencies observed there in as mentioned above the college was given an opportunity of virtual hearing vide the MARBISM letter (Hearing notice) of **even no.** dated **07.07.2023** to appear on **12.07.2023** before the designated Hearing Committee to present their case and to show cause as to **why not the conditional permission to your college with 100 seats (125 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 46 seats in 12 PG course (58 seats including EWS) namely (i) Kayachikitsa-04 seats (05 seats including EWS) (ii) Rasa Shastra and Bhaishajya Kalpana - 02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (iii) Ayurveda Samhita and Siddhant - 02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (iv) Rachna Sharir - 03 seats (04 seats including EWS) (v) Kriya Sharir - 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (vi) Swasthavritta -02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (vii) Prasuti Tantra & StriRoga - 02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (viii) Shalakyta Tantra - 05 seats (06 seats including EWS) (ix) Shalaya Tantra - 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (x) Kaumarbhritya-06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (xi) Dravyaguna Vigyan-02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (xii) Roga Nidan avum Vikriti Vigyan- 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 be denied for the Academic Year 2023-24.** The applicant college was directed to make written submission in respect of the case and produce all relevant valid documents/records/proof to substantiate the claims against all the deficiencies/shortcomings as indicated above. The representatives of the college submitted written submissions **vide letter no. GACN/Est-1/NCISM/MARB/2023/2388/2023 dated 08.07.2023** against the deficiencies conveyed to them.
5. Whereas, the college through its representatives, **Yashwant. Rajpal Patil, Principal** appeared before the Hearing Committee on **12.07.2023** and made their submission virtually as well as written submission against the shortcomings communicated to the college. The shortcomings communicated to the college, submission made by the representatives of the Ayurveda college and observations made by the Hearing Committee are as under: -

6. The observation of hearing committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report of the NCISM have been carefully re-examined in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", "The Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2022 and relevant regulations thereunder, **and once again as per the direction of President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM)**, the recommendation of Hearing Committee

was placed in the 49th Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) held on 27.07.2023.

7. In view of the observation of Hearing Committee based on the submission made by the college representatives during hearing and assessment report has been carefully examined in terms of concerned Regulation and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, and board decided that the college is fulfilling the **basic eligibility criteria for issuance of conditional permission with 100 seats (125 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 11 PG courses in the subject namely** (i) Kayachikitsa-04 seats (05 seats including EWS) (ii) Rasa Shastra and Bhaishajya Kalpana - 02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (iii) Ayurveda Samhita and Siddhant-02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (iv) Rachna Sharir - 03 seats (04 seats including EWS) (v) Swasthavritta -02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (vi) Prasuti Tantra & Stri Roga-02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (vii) Shalakya Tantra - 05 seats (06 seats including EWS) (viii) Shalaya Tantra - 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (ix) Kaumarbhritya-06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (x) Dravyaguna Vigyan-02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (xi) Roga NidanavumVikriti Vigyan-06 seats (07 seats including EWS) and not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of permission **in the dept of Kriya Sharir due to non availability of Professor which is mandatory as per PG regulation, 2016 , but Board decided to issue conditional permission as per the approved Seat Reduction Policy in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020 for failing to maintain the minimum essential standards for the Academic year 2023-24.**

"In case of non availability of Professor in the Post graduate department or specialty permission shall be granted as per the teacher student ratio by reducing the intake strength in the concerned department".

As per sub regulation 1 of regulation 16 of (PG Ayurveda Education) Regulation 2016, The teacher-student ratio shall be such that the number of post-graduate teachers to the number of post-graduate students admitted per year is maintained as 1:3 in case of Professor and 1:2 in case of Reader or Associate Professor and as per sub regulation 2 of regulation 16 of (PG Ayurveda Education) Regulation 2016The teacher student ratio shall be 1:1 in case of Lecturer or Assistant Professor having minimum of five yearsteaching experience.

In the department of Kriya Sharir, college is having 04 eligible faculty (01 Associate Professor for UG and 01 Assistant Professor for UG and 01 Assistant Professor for PG And 01 Associate Professor excess staff) and there is shortcoming of 01 Professor in the Kriya Sharir PG department and 01 Assistant Professor is having more than 05 year of teaching experience, accordingly as per the available faculty, college is not fulfilling the teacher student ratio as per the submitted seats in Part-1 and eligible for issuance of permission with 05 seats (06 seats including EWS) instead of 06 seats (07 including EWS) in the department of Kriya Sharir.

Accordingly, after applying the seat reduction policy 2023-24 under section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act 2020and as per PG Regulation 2016,college is fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria for issuance of **Conditional Permission to Government Ayurved College, Vazirabad, Nanded, Maharashtra-431601 (Inst. Id- AYU0185) with 100 seats (125 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 45 seats in 12 PG course (56 seats including EWS) [instead of 46 seats (58 seats including EWS)]** namely (1) Kayachikitsa-04 seats (05 seats Including EWS) (ii) Rasa Shastra and Bhaishajya Kalpana - 02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (iii) Ayurveda Samhita and Siddhant-02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (iv) Rachna Sharir - 03 seats (04 seats including EWS) (v) Kriya Sharir- 05 seats (06 seats including EWS) [instead of 06 seats (07 seats including EWS)] (vi) Swasthavritta -02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (vii) Prasuti Tantra & Stri Roga-02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (viii) Shalakya Tantra - 05 seats (06 seats including EWS) (ix) Shalaya Tantra - 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (x) Kaumarbhritya-06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (xi) Dravyaguna Vigyan-02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (xii) Roga Nidan avum Vikriti Vigyan-06 seats (07 seats including EWS)under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder for the academic session 2023-24.

8. Therefore, in view of shortcomings and deficiencies mentioned as above and *after applying the seat reduction policy 2023-24*, **Grant of conditional permission is issued to Government Ayurved College, Vazirabad, Nanded, Maharashtra-431601 (Inst. Id- AYU0185) for intake capacity with 100 seats (125 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 45 seats in 12 PG course (57 seats including EWS) [instead of 46 seats (58 seats including EWS)] in the subject namely** (1) Kayachikitsa-04 seats (05 seats Including EWS) (ii) Rasa Shastra and Bhaishajya Kalpana - 02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (iii) Ayurveda Samhita and Siddhant-02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (iv) Rachna Sharir - 03 seats (04 seats including EWS) (v) Kriya Sharir- 05 seats (06 seats including EWS) [instead of 06 seats (07 seats including EWS)] (vi) Swasthavritta -02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (vii) Prasuti Tantra & Stri Roga-02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (viii) Shalakya Tantra - 05 seats (06 seats including EWS) (ix) Shalaya Tantra - 06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (x) Kaumarbhritya-06 seats (07 seats including EWS) (xi) Dravyaguna Vigyan-02 seats (03 seats including EWS) (xii) Roga Nidan avumVikriti Vigyan-06 seats (07 seats including EWS) under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic year 2023-24.
- (i) It is further informed that minimum **15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 100 seats (125 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 15% of postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 45 seats in 12 PG course (57 seats including EWS) [instead of 46 seats (58 seats including EWS)]** seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2023-24 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
9. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.

10. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
11. Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
12. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2023 **and send a compliance report to get permission for the academic session 2024-25:**
- All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
 - All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016
 - all the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto;
 - All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);
13. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2024-25.
