Procedure for Selection and Admission to Post Basic Diploma in Ayurveda Specialty Nursing (Residency Program) at the Government Ayurved Nursing College, Government Ayurved College and Hospital Campus, Vazirabad, Nanded under the Directorate, AYUSH, is being published for the academic year 2026 – 2027

1. **General:** Maharashtra State Board of Nursing and Paramedical Education, Mumbai Affiliated Post Basic Diploma in Ayurveda Specialty Nursing (Residency Program) (1 Year) admission process will be implemented by the Government.

The Government of Maharashtra vide Letter No. _____, dt. _____ permitted to the Directorate of AYUSH, Mumbai to admit the eligible candidates for Post Basic Diploma in Ayurveda Specialty Nursing (Residency Program) for the academic year 2026 - 27

2. Competent Authority, Nodal Officers and their functions:

- 2.1. The admission process will be carried out through the Competent Authority and the authorized officers. The Director, AYUSH Mumbai shall be the Competent Authority in this regard and the institution wise Nodal officers are as follows:

2.2. Functions of Competent Authority:

The Competent Authority, through the Nodal officers appointed by it, shall implement the admission process and control the selection process in accordance with the said rules and act as the appellate authority in this regard if the candidates make a report. The competent authority shall make necessary arrangements for the enforcement of these rules. The competent authority or the nodal officers appointed to present in the case of petitions filed in the Courts in this regard on behalf of the Maharashtra Government as per the instructions given from time to time.

2.3. Function of Nodal Officers:

The Nodal Officers under the control of the Competent Authority will distribute the Admission forms. Accept and scrutinize Application forms and publish the merit list. If any candidate challenges the decision regarding admission in the court, in that case as well as directed by the Competent Authority from time-to-time, Nodal officers has to plead in Courts on behalf of the Government and/or Competent Authority.

2.4. A candidate seeking admission should submit an Application form for Post Basic Diploma in Ayurveda specialty Nursing in the prescribed format at the respective institute.

2.5. Prescribed specimen Application form may be obtained from the Principal, Government Ayurved Nursing College, Nanded. Applications fully filled in all aspects should be submitted through proper channel by the In-service candidates under AYUSH/DMER/DHS on or before the date notified by the Competent Authority. Late applications will not be accepted at any condition. Private candidates will submit their complete fully filled form to the respective institute. Merit List will be displayed at respective institute by the Nodal officers.

3. Eligibility criteria:

- a. The candidates having Indian citizenship will be eligible for admission. (Certificate of Nationality must be attached.)
- b. Maximum age limit will be 45 years for open category candidates and **50** years for reserved category candidates as on **31st July, 2026**.

4. Educational Qualification & Work Experience:

- a. Candidate should have passed Higher Secondary Certificate Examination of Maharashtra State Board of Secondary Examination or equivalent examination recognized in Maharashtra State.
- b. Candidates whose parents are natives of Maharashtra State, but the candidates have passed Secondary School Examination or equivalent and/or Higher Secondary School Examination from an institution outside the State of Maharashtra, such candidate is also eligible for admission, provided such candidates must submit original Domicile Certificate duly signed by the District Magistrate or Metropolitan Magistrate.
- c. All candidate must have passed GNM Nursing or Basic B.Sc Nursing examination from training school of nursing / Nursing college and institution recognized by State Nursing Council & Indian Nursing Council.
- d. As per the Norms of Indian Nursing Council the candidate should be registered as a Nurse and Midwife with Maharashtra Nursing Council. Also, the said registration should have been renewed till **March 2027**.
- e. Government In-service candidates must have completed five years of continuous Government service till **31st July, 2026**. The candidate must submit a work experience certificate from the authority.

- f. In service Candidate should submit their applications through proper channel only. A Merit list will be prepared based on the applications received within the prescribed time. Late Applications received will not be considered. Also, by Post/Xerox/Advance copies of Application will not be accepted.
- g. A student Other than Inservice (Govt. service) must possess a minimum of one-year clinical experience as staff nurse in recognized institute / hospital. Experience will be calculated from the date of registration with Maharashtra Nursing Council as a Nurse and Midwife till **31st July, 2026**.

5. **Constitutional Reservation:**

5.1. Reservation for Reserved category candidates are as follows:

Reservation policy will be followed for admission as per the existing rules of Maharashtra Government.

- 5.2. Applicants for reserved categories (1) to (8) mentioned above must attach the Caste Certificate & Caste Validity Certificate from the Competent authority with the application form.
- 5.3. The benefit of reservation shall not be admissible to the candidates belonging to the creamy layer groups of above (3 to 8) categories. However, it is mandatory to submit the Non Creamy Layer certificate from the Competent authority **valid up to 31/03/2027**. As per Government Resolution, Social Justice, Cultural Work and Special Assistance No.CBC.10/2008/Pra.No.697/ dated 16 December 2017, in revised prescribed format that they do not fall under the Creamy layer category. Old Non-Creamy Layer Certificate will not be considered.
- 5.4. If the seats in the reserved category (1) to (7) remain vacant, shall be filled among the remaining reserved category according to their inter-se-Group-merit. If the seats still remain vacant then, these seats will be filled by Inter- se- Group merit from the General category candidates.

5.4.1. Reservation Inter-se Group will be as follows-

Group-1.

- a) Scheduled Castes and Schedule Caste converted to Buddhism (S.C.)
- b) Scheduled Tribes including those living out-side specified area (S.T.)

Group-2.

- a) Vimukta Jati (DT) (A)
- b) Nomadic Tribes (NT1(B))

Group-3.

- a) Nomadic Tribes (NT2 (C))
- b) Nomadic Tribes(NT3 (D))
- c) Other Backward Classes (OBC) including SBC

5.4.2. If the seats still remain vacant, then the seats will be filled, from among the candidates of all reserved categories mentioned above.

5.4.3. If the seats still remain vacant then the seats will be filled from among the candidates of the common merit list.

5.4.4. If the seats remained vacant from SEBC category and EWS quota, then the seats will be filled from general category candidates.

5.5. While considering reservation category seats, reserved candidates who have been selected on merit (without benefit of reservation) such seats will not be counted for reserved seats.

5.6. If the seats in AYUSH/DMER/DHS candidates (Govt. Seats) mentioned in the distribution of seats for said course remains vacant, shall be filled among remaining AYUSH/DMER/DHS candidate according to inter se group. If the seats still remain vacant these seats shall be filled by inter se group from private candidate in order to fulfill the government seats quota. If Private quota candidates are not available then vacant seats will be filled from the In-service candidates of AYUSH/DMER/DHS as per merit.

6. Reservation for candidates with disabilities (PWD) shall be indicated as below:

6.1. As per the provision of Revised Notification of Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi, No F-1.5/2018 /INC dated 10/04/2019, out of the total seats, 5% of seats will be reserved for locomotor disability candidates. Constitutional reservation will be applied parallelly within PWD quota seats. **Any seat remaining vacant will be reverted back to respective category.**

6.2. Candidates applying for seats reserved for persons with disability must submit a certificate of their disability from the Competent authority signed by Civil Surgeon/Medical Board of District General Hospitals/Medical Superintendent of Government Medical College and Hospital or Director, All India Institute of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, Haji Ali, Mumbai in the prescribed format (**Annexure-B**). Candidates should attach the certified true copy of such certificate along with their application.

Candidate must have 40 percent of Locomotor disability. Candidates having disability more than 50 percent are not eligible for admission for Nursing courses. Disability other than Locomotor is not allowed as per the rules. However, the verification of disability of the candidates will be done through a medical board constituted by the Competent authority for this purpose.

7. Reservation for Orphan candidates:

As per Government Resolution dated 23.8.2021, 1% parallel reservation will be applicable to the said candidate in education and employment. Accordingly, the candidates should submit the certificate from Department of Women and Child Welfare Development.

8. Reservation for Economically Weaker Sections (EWS):

As per Government Resolution No. 4015/P.No.3.2/16-A dated 12th February 2019, reservation of 10% seats to be given to the Economically Weaker Sections. Submission of certificate from Competent Authority in prescribed form (**Annexure-C**) shall be mandatory for availing reservation for Economically Weaker Section (EWS).

9. Socially and Educationally Backward Classes (SEBC): As per Maharashtra State Reservation for Socially and Educationally Backward Classes Act, 2024 published in the Maharashtra Govt. Gazette, Part VIII on **26th Feb, 2024, reservation of 10% to be given to SEBC.**

10. Application Form and Documents: The admission brochure and Admission form fees for Post Basic Diploma in Ayurveda nursing will be **Rs. 1000/-** for open category and **Rs. 500/-** for reserved category.

11. Admission form and Documents to be submitted for Post Basic Diploma in Ayurveda Specialty Nursing.

11.1 All applicants must submit the attested true copies of following documents with the admission form:

- a) Age and Nationality
- b) Domicile Certificate issued by the competent authority.
- c) General Nursing and Midwifery / Basic BSC Nursing all Years mark sheets (including failure marksheets) and Passing certificate Diploma or Degree Certificate.
- d) Higher Secondary School Certificate Examination 12th (10+2) or equivalent examination Mark sheet and certificate.
- e) Secondary School Certificate (SSC) and mark sheet.
- f) Nursing school/College Leaving Certificate
- g) Maharashtra Nursing Council Registration Certificate with Renewal till 2027, additional qualification and having NUID number.
- h) Caste certificate (For Reserved category)
- i) Caste Validity Certificate (For Reserved category)
- j) Non-Creamy Layer Certificate (for candidates applying for reserved seats in Reserved category other than Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes) having validity till 31st March 2027.

- k) For Person with disability (PWD), Orphan and Economically Weaker Section (EWS) candidates, certificate in prescribed format by the Competent Authority.
- l) Experience Certificate from the Head of the Institute for Government candidates.
- m) Attempt Certificate
- n) Medical Fitness Certificate
- o) No Objection Certificate by Head of the Institute for In-service Government Candidates.
- p) The Candidates other than In-service (Govt. service), possess a minimum of one year clinical experience as staff nurse certificate from the recognized institute/hospital.

11.2. All original documents are mandatory on the day of counseling for admission to Post Basic Diploma In Ayurveda Specialty Nursing course, Receipts and Undertaking will not be accepted.

11.3. Medical Certificate of Physical Fitness: Candidate must be physically and mentally fit to complete this course. Candidates should submit a Medical Certificate from the Registered Medical Practitioner regarding their physical fitness along with the application form in prescribed format (**Annexure A**). Also, Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Full Participation and Protection of Rights) Act, 1995, Section 2 (T) As Per INC notification F.No.1-5/20018-INC dated 10.04.2019 for disable candidates reservation is considered with a disability of locomotor to the tune of 40% - 50% of the lower extremity. Candidate is required to submit the proof of his/her disability by way of a Certificate issued by Certificate issuing authority

11.4. Admission forms will not be considered unless the following conditions are met :

- a. Admission forms should be duly, accurately and completely filled.
- b. Substantiation of the claim made in the application form should be accompanied by the true copies of all necessary certificates. Any admission application not accompanied by certified true copies will not be considered.
- c. Application for admission should be received at the office of the authorized Nodal Officer by the final scheduled date and time.
- d. No such application shall be considered if the attested xerox copies of all necessary certificates are not attached with the application.
- e. At the time of admission all necessary original certificates shall be handed over to the Principal, Government Ayurved Nursing College, Nanded. These original certificates will be returned to the candidates after completing the course or leaving the institution.
- f. Photocopies of certificates submitted later for any reason after submission of admission application will not be accepted. Candidate should fill admission form properly and carefully.
- g. Candidates who are currently serving in Government service must submit their applications through proper channel i.e. through the Head of the Institute/ Office where they employed alongwith the covering letter and No Objection Certificate (NOC), to the Institution where they seek admission. Candidate should not submit Applications to the Directorate, nor send it by post, nor deposit it directly in the Directorate's mail.

Applications received by the Directorate will not be considered, Candidate should take note of this. The Candidates of DHS (Commissioner / Director Health Services) should send their applications to the concerned institution for admission through their headquarters / prescribed channels. If there is any delay by the Headquarter / Candidates in submitting the application of DHS candidates within the prescribed time frame, the said applications will not be accepted and the entire responsibility will remain with the DHS candidates.

11.5. For In-Service Government Candidates: The In-service candidate of a Government hospital must submit “No Objection Certificate” from their hospital along with the application.

11.5.1 According to Maharashtra Civil Service Leave Rules, 1981 Chapter Seven Study Leave (80 to 93). In-service Government candidates, procedure will be followed regarding Study Leave as per the provisions of Maharashtra Civil Service Study Leave Rules 80 to 93 of the Leave Rules, 1981. The decision regarding study leave will be taken by the respective Competent authority.

11.5.2. **Bond** : Candidates admitted through In-service quota will have to submit a bond in the prescribed format to serve the government for 05 years after completion of course. If the candidate does not serve the government for 05 years after completing the course, then the salary and allowance paid during the course period will be recovered as per the government rules.

If the In-service quota candidates are not available, then vacant seats will be filled from private candidates as per merit or inter se group. If Private quota candidates are not available then vacant seats will be filled from the In-service candidates of AYUSH/DMER/DHS as per merit.

13. **Merit List-** Merit List will be prepared on the basis of aggregate marks obtained in all years of General Nursing and Midwifery examination or Basic B.Sc. Nursing examination. Candidates will be selected through interview based on the merit list.

Tie Breakers: - In case of equal aggregate marks then: -

13.1 First preference: A candidate with aggregate higher marks in HSC / 12th Standard examination shall be preferred. If the tie still persists then :

13.2 Second Preference: A candidate with aggregate higher marks in S.S.C. / 10th Standard examination shall be preferred. If the tie still persists, then:

13.3 Third Preference: The candidate those who is senior by age will be given preference.

14. Selection Process:

- 14.1. Provisional merit list of eligible candidates will be displayed on the Notice Board of office of the Principal of Government Ayurved Nursing College, Government Ayurved College and Hospital Campus, Vazirabad, Nanded. Objections raised by the candidates regarding provisional Merit List will be considered (with correction, if necessary) and will be published at the place specified above within a prescribed period mentioned in the schedule of Admission Brochure.
- 14.2. Eligible Candidates qualified as per merit list should report for counselling on given date as per Information Brochure with all original documents at the Government Ayurved Nursing College, Nanded.
- 14.3. The final selection list of the candidates selected on the basis of merit in the counselling process will be published at the place specified above. Selection orders will be issued to the selected candidates at Government Ayurved Nursing College, Nanded. **Selected candidates who do not join the institute within time declared by Authority, he/she will not have any claim for admission on the selected seat.** Selected candidates vacant seats will be filled within the prescribed period from the waiting list according to the quota. The final decision regarding the selection process will rest with selection committee.
- 14.4. Candidates must submit the original documents immediately to the Principal of Government Ayurved Nursing College, Nanded at the time of admission. Also, the payment of the prescribed fee has to be paid subsequently by the selected candidate.
- 14.5. Final admission of selected candidate will be subject to the approval by Maharashtra State Board of Nursing and Paramedical Education, Mumbai.

15. Fees:

- 15.1. The tuition fees for this course shall be as per the Government of Maharashtra from time to time.
- 15.2. Hostel facility will be depended on the availability of the accommodation. All the candidates may not get hostel facilities.
- 15.3. Selected candidates will have to pay the one year course fees at the time of admission. Admission of candidates will be confirmed only after payment of admission fees.
- 15.4 Fees structure as per Government letter no nursing -2025/L.NO.105 /SERVICE -5 (E-1055024) dated 17 April 2025, the course fees are applicable.

Apart from the above fees, MSBNPE examination and other fees will be charged as per MSBNPE rules. Fees will remain permissible as per the orders of the Government from time to time.

- 15.5 If the Government implements a Scholarship scheme for this course, the eligible candidate will get the benefit of the scholarship scheme i.e. Education fee waiver schemes such as, Schemes for Reserved Category, Children of ex-servicemen, Primary/Secondary school teachers etc. will be admissible to the candidates as per the orders of the Government of Maharashtra in force from time to time.
16. **Penalty** : If the Candidate has cancelled his/her admission for any reason after the cut-off date declared by the concerned authority, then the candidate has to pay the amount Rs. 1,00,000/- (One Lakh only) as a penalty for lapse of seat.

17. Conduct and discipline for the students

- 17.1. It is mandatory for the selected candidate to pay the prescribed tuition fees in time.
- 17.2. It is mandatory to submit different bonds namely Affidavit for Educational Gap (if applicable), Affidavit for Laps of Seat , Affidavit for Attendance as per rules and Bond in case of In-service candidate along with all the original documents.
- 17.3. Admitted candidates shall be bounded by the relevant rules of conduct and discipline of the Institute and MSBNPE.

- 17.4. If any student is found to be involved in Anti-national activities against the provisions of the laws and regulations of the Government from time to time, the Principal may rusticate the student from the institution without prior notice.
- 17.5. Selected candidates should not remain absent in the academic session. All absent candidates will be dealt with as per rules. However, in case of absent candidates in Government service, a written report will be sent by the institute to the concerned offices.
- 17.6. Any statement or information provided by the candidate in the application form is found to be false/incorrect at any time thereafter, his/her admission will be cancelled. The fees paid by him /her will be forfeited and he/she may be removed from the college by the Principal and action will be taken against him/her as per Government rules.
- 17.7. The student involved in ragging after admission, he/she will be expelled as per the MSBNPE rules.
- 17.8. It is mandatory for the student to complete the Post Basic Diploma in Ayurveda Specialty Nursing (Residency Program) in maximum three attempts as per the norms of Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi and MSBNPE Mumbai.
18. **Grievance Redressal Authority (All General):** Any complaint regarding the admission process shall be dealt with by the Competent Authority / Nodal Officers.
19. **Legal Jurisdiction:**
All disputes / legal matters pertaining to the selection process of course will be dealt within the Jurisdiction of courts at Mumbai only. The Competent Authority shall be the legal person in whose name the Government of Maharashtra may sue or may be sued.
